

## Jellyfish Windsock

1. Take two clear kitchen trash bags, crumple one of the bags into a ball and stuff it into the corner of the other bag.
2. Tape around the bottom of the ball to form a neck.
3. Cut part of the trash bag hanging down into long strips to make tentacles.
4. Push a string through the neck of the jellyfish and tie the two ends together to make a hanger for the windsock.
5. To make fish to get caught in the tentacles cut two identical shapes from clear contact paper.
6. Peel the backing off one shape and decorate with colored tissue paper and sequins.
7. Cut out an eye and add a pupil.
8. Cover the decorated fish with the other piece on contact paper.
9. Staple the fish to the tentacle.
