# Wildlife Lighting

Florida hosts the largest loggerhead sea turtle nesting population in the world. What happens to our sea turtles greatly affects the world's population!

Poorly managed artificial lights on coastal properties confuse sea turtles, causing them to wander toward landward sources of light and often die in the process.



We can help you protect sea turtles and bring your property into compliance by removing unnecessary exterior lights and replacing necessary fixtures using the following rules:



## Keep it Low

Mount fixtures low to the ground and use lower watts and lumens.



## Keep it Shielded

Shield light sources so they are not visible from the beach.



## Keep it Long

Use long wavelength lights at 560 nm or longer.
