Sea Turtle Conservancy is excited to announce their 5th annual "Tee Off for Turtles" sea turtle awareness and fundraiser golf outing at Aquarina Country Club located in the heart of the Archie Carr National Wildlife Refuge, one of the most significant sea turtle nesting beaches in the world!

Sea Turtle Conservancy was founded in 1959 by sea turtle expert Dr. Archie Carr. Dr. Carr was dedicated to saving these ancient creatures from extinction through science-based conservation. Over the course of 57 years of research and advocacy Sea Turtle Conservancy has yielded much of what is known about sea turtles and the threats they face, and is applying this knowledge to carry out some of the world's most successful sea turtle protection and recovery programs.

Sea Turtle Conservancy has partnered with Brevard County's Environmentally Endangered Lands Program for 26 years to help protect its fragile natural resources and important sea turtle nesting habitat and offers education and stewardship opportunities at the Barrier Island Sanctuary in the Archie Carr Refuge.

"Tee Off for Turtles" will be held on Saturday, March 4th, just as leatherback sea turtles begin their nesting season in the Refuge. Registration begins at 12 p.m. Golfers will receive complimentary goody bags and may purchase "Mull-egg-ans" and tickets to participate in the "Nearest to the Nest", "Longest Migration", and "Turtle Track" contests prior play. Team play will begin at 1 p.m. with a shotgun start and scramble format. Following play participants will enjoy a cookout at Aquarina's Brassie Grille, winners will be awarded cash prizes and everyone can join in chance drawings for golf and sea turtle gifts.
